

EINA IDEA CONVOCA · Collaboration grants with the project *Aurèlia Muñoz. Aerial atelier*

Eina Idea launches three collaboration grants open to EINA / UAB masters or PhD students, in relation to *Aurèlia Muñoz. Aerial atelier*, an exhibition curated by Eina Idea which will open in March 2023 in the Centre Grau-Garriga d'Art Tèxtil Contemporani, in Sant Cugat del Vallès (Barcelona). The grants aim to involve graduate students in the workshops that will orbit the exhibition; in the elaboration of the critical publication that will document the project; and in its graphic design.

Aurèlia Muñoz. Aerial atelier departs from the works by Aurèlia Muñoz (1926-2011) in the collection of Sant Cugat's City Council, as well as a selection of elements from the artist's personal archive. The project conceives an exhibition in constant activation and redefinition, transcending the textile realm in many a direction and providing alternate readings to the canonical interpretation of Muñoz.

Research and publication collaboration grant

The collaboration will involve a research process and the writing of a critical chronology / biographical essay / historical analysis of Aurèlia Muñoz's practice to be published in the exhibition catalogue. The required profile for the collaboration will include an active literary practice in Spanish and/or Catalan, skills in critical analysis and knowledge of historical-artistic research's standards. This collaboration will involve the publication of the essay and a fee of 500€.

Graphic design collaboration grant

The collaboration will consist of the co-creation of the exhibition's graphics and its applications (catalogue, museography and signage), as well as its communication in analogue and digital formats. The required profile should demonstrate expertise in Adobe Creative Suite (InDesign, Photoshop, Illustrator, Premiere Pro) and provide a portfolio of recent projects which are representative of their approach to graphic design. This collaboration involves a commitment of 70h, to be remunerated according to EINA's internship fee. The working hours will be distributed throughout 9 months and the schedule will be decided collectively according to availability.

Production and coordination collaboration grant

The collaboration will consist of a supporting role in the preparation and logistics of the exhibition, the production and coordination of the workshops and events accompanying it, as well as in the liaison with invited creative agents. The required profile should demonstrate an interest in exhibition and spatial design, as well as in coordination and organisation of artistic and/or cultural events. Experience in exhibition production or setup will be positively valued. This collaboration involves a commitment of 70h, to be remunerated according to EINA's internship fee. The working hours will be distributed throughout 9 months and the schedule will be decided collectively according to availability.
