Get to know Eina



Eina is a foundation made up of three complementary platforms with a flexible and dynamic structure that allows them to adapt to social, ecological, cultural and economic changes.

The Foundation is made up of Eina University Centre, einaidea and Eina Obra. The aim of these institutions is to offer learning and training environments through transversal and interdisciplinary projects at the service of the educational community and society in general.

Studying at Eina means acquiring professional skills in design through an interdisciplinary, reflective and environmentally-conscious approach.

We offer comprehensive training ranging from undergraduate degrees in

design to Masters', postgraduate and doctoral courses, and our degrees bear the stamp of the Autonomous University of Barcelona.

Our teaching methodology enhances the specific skills and abilities of each student so that they develop professionally to become leaders and drivers of collective transformation.

We understand learning as a networked activity, linked to cultural entities, companies, research projects and professional clusters.

We promote the transition towards a sustainable future by ensuring our alumni are professionally equipped to deal with a changing world, and that they develop their capacity to adapt to change as well as their ability to solve complex and multi-faceted problems. We aim to train future graduates who will have a positive impact on the eco-social and material development of our planet in a global context through innovative, inter-connected and responsible design practices.

Eina is located in a privileged setting, at the gates of the Collserola Natural Park. Located in the liminal space between city and nature, it has a Living Lab that acts as a gateway to Collserola for the city of Barcelona. It is a unique location where to develop co-located practices and advanced research in design and art.



The campus



The Eina campus is built around two buildings: Sentmenat and Bosc, both located at the foot of the Collserola Natural Park, in the Sarrià district of Barcelona.



Eina Sentmenat

The main headquarters of Eina is located in the Palace of the Marquises of Sentmenat, a historic building that this aristocratic family converted into a residence in the 17th century, and which underwent renovations in the 19th century. During the 1994-1995 academic year, Eina courses were moved from the original headquarters at Casa Manuel Dolcet, established in 1966, to Sentmenat.



Eina Bosc

Eina Bosc is a 1,500 m² space which opened in February 2022 and which comprises a mixture of workshops and versatile spaces open to transversal and interdisciplinary creation and experimentation. It has all the spatial, human and logistical support necessary to provide a full range of educational activities addressing all academic levels.

Facilities



Eina students, alumni and faculty have access to the following facilities. Each of these spaces has a designated team of professionals tasked with assisting users of the space during and outside school hours.

Library (Eina Sentmenat) - biblioteca@eina.cat

The Eina Library provides the educational community with the necessary resources for teaching, research and the development of cultural activities. Thanks to its specialized collection focused on contemporary art and design, the Eina Library has become a reference center for students, scholars and researchers interested in these subjects.

Graphic Creation Workshop (Eina Bosc) - taller@eina.cat

This unique space houses theoretical and practical training in the different processes of production, self-publishing and graphic creation. It is equipped with specialized machinery for different analog printing techniques such as lithography, silkscreen printing, engraving, cyanotype, chalcography and woodcut, among others. It also has several work spaces such as the photography laboratory, acid-dyeing lab, and dark room for exposing and developing photographs.

Model and prototype workshop (Eina Bosc) - gravat@eina.cat

It functions as a theoretical/practical training space in subjects that require specific tools. It is also a creative space for experimentation and research for the production of elements that, in the design process, require models and prototypes, either through traditional techniques or digital manufacturing.

Photography studio (Eina Bosc) - medialab@eina.cat

Audiovisual production space equipped with 7 continuous LED lights, daylight lamp, tripods, reflectors, windows, paper backgrounds, and also with all the necessary accessories required for any small-format production. The space is also equipped with portable equipment for working outdoors.

Canteen (Eina Sentmenat)

At Sentmenat you will find the canteen, a meeting point to take a break between classes, share anecdotes and projects with friends. The canteen is complemented by the microwave service available in Sentmenat and Bosc.

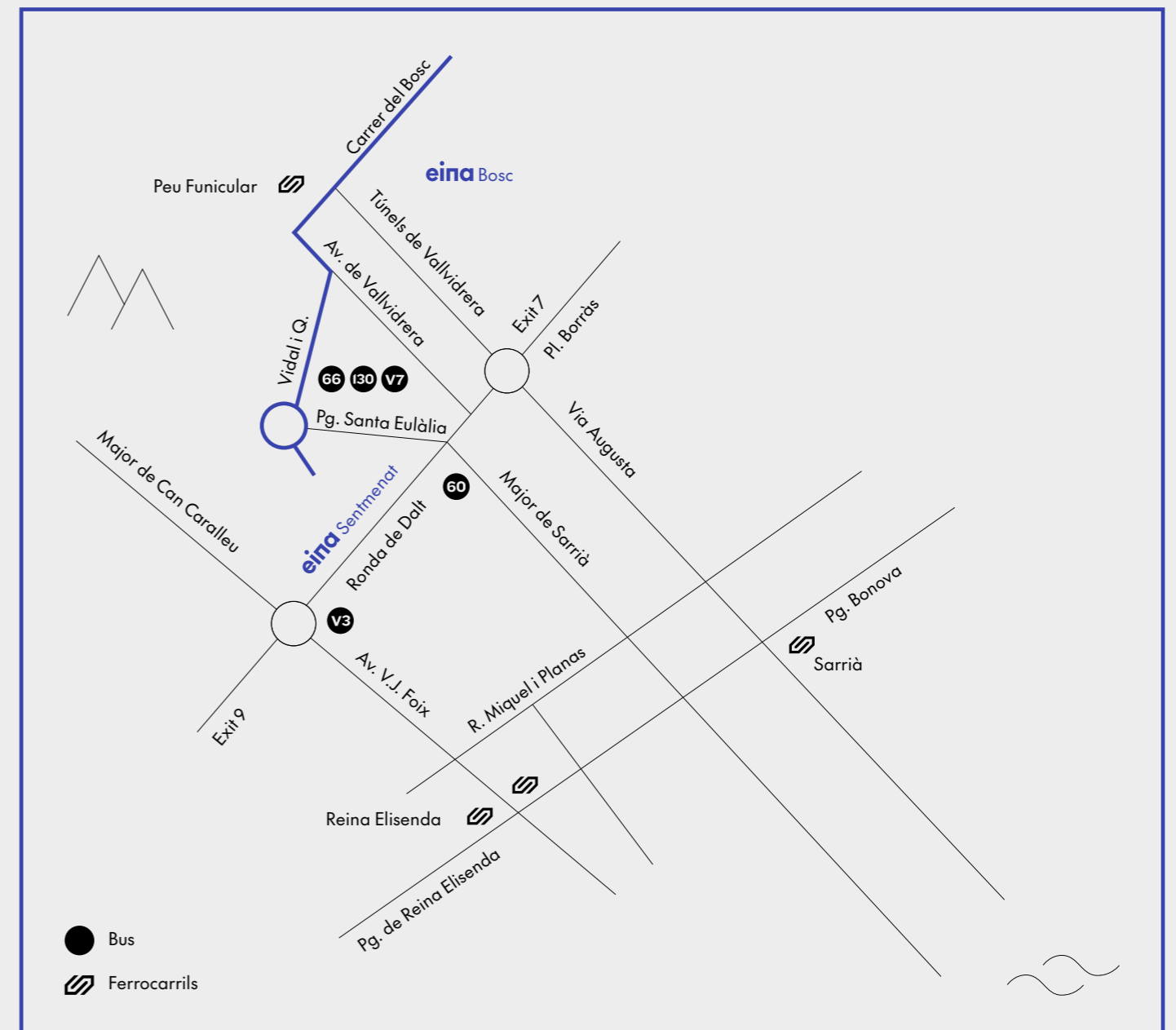
