

Scholarships PERI/FERAL Fundació Eina. Course 2026-2027

The EINA Foundation, within the framework of the PERI/FERAL programme, offers two scholarships as well as the possibility of tuition fee reductions for its students. The two scholarships are subject to the condition that all available places on the programme have been filled, while tuition fee reductions may be applied in a wider number of cases depending on eligibility.

Students enrolled in the PERI/FERAL programme may submit their application and request a scholarship once their profile has been deemed suitable for participation by the teaching team. Each scholarship will be awarded according to the conditions defined by the programme (see below). The scholarships provide a 50% and 80% exemption, respectively, from the initial tuition fee. Tuition fee reductions, applicable to a broader number of students, will be **10%** or **20%**.

The PERI/FERAL programme establishes several levels of financial support for participants depending on their situation. In all cases, supporting documentation will be required to verify the accuracy of the information provided.

Scholarship eligibility

- Individuals in a situation of dependency who, for this reason, face difficulties in their professional or economic activity; that is, individuals with dependent immediate family members or spouses (due to disability, health issues, lack of autonomy, or other reasons).
- Individuals in situations of social vulnerability: victims of abuse, refugees due to political or gender-based exclusion in their countries of origin, and particularly those from territories affected by armed conflict.
- Individuals experiencing unemployment or economic precarity, defined as having had annual gross income below €16,500 during the previous year.

Applicants wishing to apply for one of the two scholarships must meet at least one of these criteria.

Tuition fee reduction eligibility

- Individuals experiencing unemployment or economic precarity, defined as having had annual gross income below €16,500 during the previous year.
- Indicators of quality, talent and potential within the application will also be taken into account. The evaluation of these qualitative indicators will consider the applicant's motivation, academic and professional background, as well as their potential contribution to the programme.

The evaluation committee for these scholarships and tuition fee reductions will be composed of the Management of the Foundation, the Management of einaidea, and the Coordination of the PERI/FERAL programme.
